The concerns we raised at the last meeting have not been addressed and we urge to reject this revision and have it re-written.

First, it does not address what happens or who will discipline staff if it is the superintendent who violates the policy. And according to the policy, the agreement between UC Merced and the District which was signed unlawfully by board member Woo would violate this agreement.

Second, it excludes Governing Board members from defining when such a conflict would arise

Given all the controversy about conflict of interest at SCUSD, get this one right.
