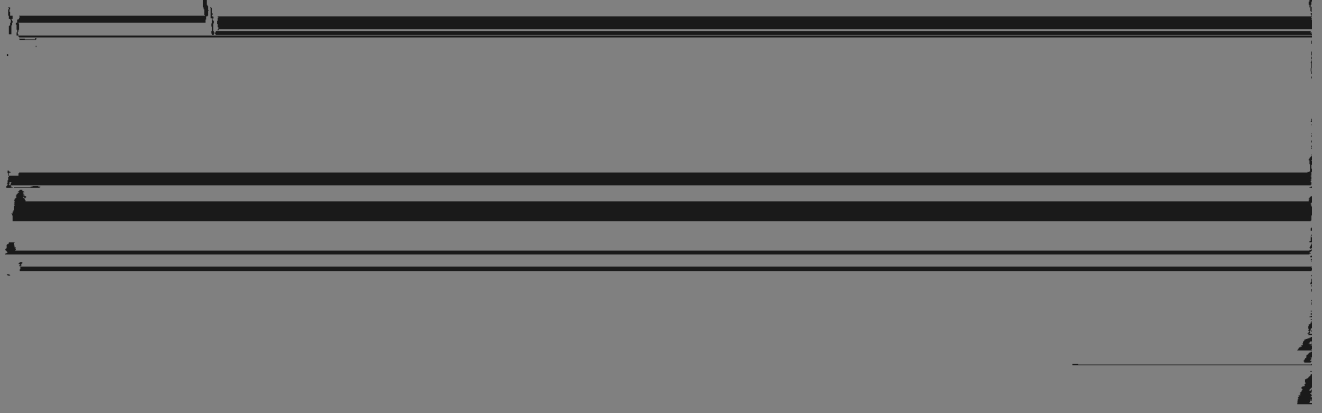

will not allow the children to return to school 5 days/full time now or in the fall. This is also an arbitrary rule since the CDC and California Dept of Public Health have revised distancing requirements to 3 feet. While we have made progress on getting schools open, we are not yet there, and a 6-foot spacing agreement will create huge barriers on returning kids to classrooms. SCUSD and the board should not agree to a 6-foot distance proposed by SCTA.
