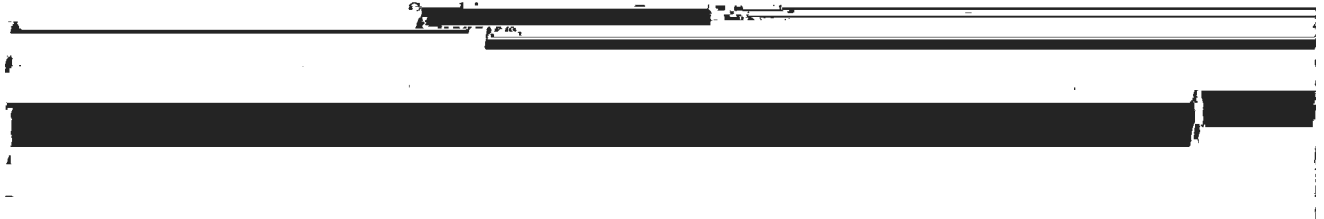
Comment: SAVE OUR STUDENTS
