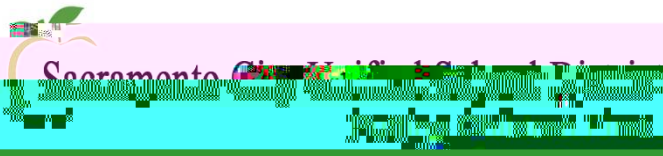

*Students graduate as globally competitive lifelong learners, prepared to succeed in a career and higher education institution of their choice to secure gainful employment and contribute to society.*

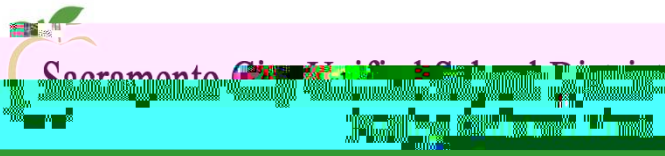

Expanded Learning/YDSS provide summer programming that aim to prevent summer learning loss and childhood obesity through thematic programs, service learning projects and internships.

- To provide information, educational resources, and activities to families, that will enhance youth and adult learning.

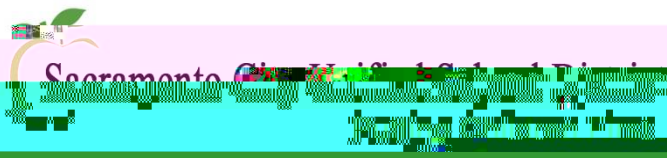




# Overview of Expanded Learning Services

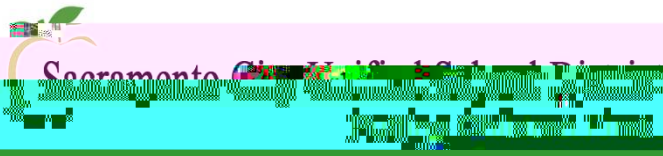
# Review of *Request for Qualifications*

Contents for RFQ:

Narrative Guidelines and Requirements

- Narrative not to exceed 10 pages single spaced, 12-point font, Times New Roman/Ariel, one inch margin on each side
- Pages numbered – begin on first page of Narrative section
- Agency name on every page
- Don't forget your cover page: Appendix A
- Due to COVID-19, electronic signatures will be accepted if using AdobeSign or DocuSign.
