

within each of the three legs of the process. Vice President Murawski gave her thoughts on the role of the Board in this process, and she looks forward to seeing the data. She asked if the data will be available after the Board adopts the plan. Mr. Covington said the data will be available to staff early next week, and he said how it communicates to the community will be brought back to the Board for approval. Vice President Murawski asked what the master plan will entail. Ms. Ramos shared more information on the assessments.
